

Cleaning Tips

- ◇ Soft Scrub is excellent for getting crayon off of plastic toys, tables, etc.
- ◇ Clorox Bleach Pen can be used to spot treat a bad stain on a clothing item that can't otherwise be bleached (i.e. a pink dress with a white collar, you can spot treat just the collar with bleach)
- ◇ Mr. Clean Magic Eraser will get pencil, crayon or scuff marks off wood
- ◇ Rub shampoo directly on shirt to get out "ring around the collar"
- ◇ Rubbing alcohol helps remove stickers (white vinegar can be used on wood)
- ◇ Stuffed animals can be easily cleaned by placing inside a pillowcase with the end tied and running it through the washing machine (make sure it does NOT have a voice box or other electronics)
- ◇ Soak clothes in warm vinegar and water mixture to remove perspiration stains
- ◇ For all purpose laundry cleaning, to get the dingy out of the white and for stain removal, use the Stain Removal Formula below.

STAIN REMOVAL FORMULA

Fill washer 1/2 with hot water.
Pour in: 1 Cup Powder Detergent, 1 Cup Clorox 2 and
1 Cup Dishwasher Powder Detergent
Agitate.
Add clothes.
Soak over night.
Next day, finish filling tub with water.
Let the washing machine finish cycling.
Then completely rewash clothes as normal.
